1. Under Part One, Notes Section, Note E is hereby modified to include the following:

For purposes of receiving the following benefits and privileges prescribed under SOFA:

Certified contractor employees may be accorded the same privileges as a Company Grade Officer with regards to commissary; morale, welfare, and recreation (MRW); exchange; BOQ accommodations; vehicle registration and licensing; messing; military FPO postal services, including post office boxes; and other available military logistical support. These privileges may only be granted when it is within the capability of the servicing organization and on a space available basis. The granting of these privileges shall not impair the military mission.

Certified contractor employees may receive medical services at on-base medical facilities on a reimbursable basis. The contractor or contractor employee is responsible for reimbursing the Government for the full cost for the use of these services.

If space is available, dependents of certified contractor employees may be granted access to DoD Schools on a reimbursable basis.

A CONFORMED COPY OF THE REVISED CONTRACT IS MADE A PART OF THIS MODIFICATION AS A RESULT OF THE CHANGES OUTLINED HEREIN.
